The processing of the data provided will be carried out in automated and/or manual form, in compliance with the provisions of Article 32 of GDPR 2016/679, by specially appointed persons such as employees and associates of FederUnacoma S.u.r.l. and in compliance with the provisions of Articles 28 and 29 GDPR 2016/ 679 (the list of Data Processors is available from the Data Controller for consultation). In addition, the Data Controller may communicate your Data to the subjects to whom the communication is due by virtue of legal obligations. Data will not be transferred outside the European Union. The data will be kept for a period of time not exceeding the achievement of the purposes for which they are processed and in any case in compliance with the prescriptive term provided by law.
